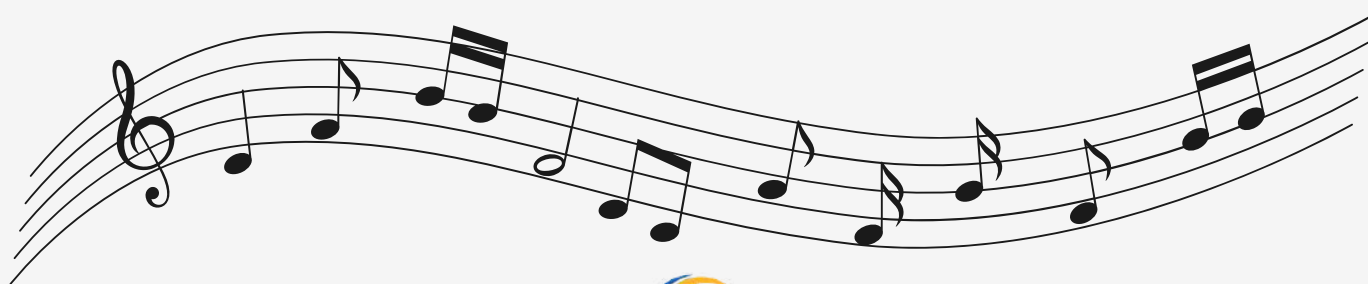
The highlight? A wonderful pair-share reflection where students beamed with pride, wearing their paper crowns and celebrating what makes each of them unique.

Learning Beyond the Classroom

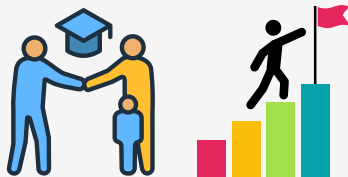

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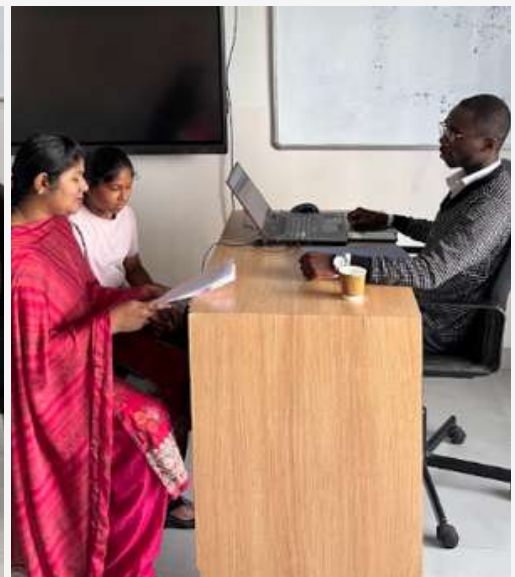

Discovering Density Through Hands-on Learning

Grade 8 CIE students participated in an exciting hands-on activity to determine the density of an irregular object. By measuring its mass using a digital balance and calculating its volume through the water displacement method.



Well-being Activity: Learning to Manage Emotions

As part of the school's Well-being Programme, students participated in an engaging session on the NAIL IT model—Name, Accept, Investigate, and Let It Go. Through interactive discussions and personal reflections, students learned to recognise, express, and manage their emotions in a healthy way. 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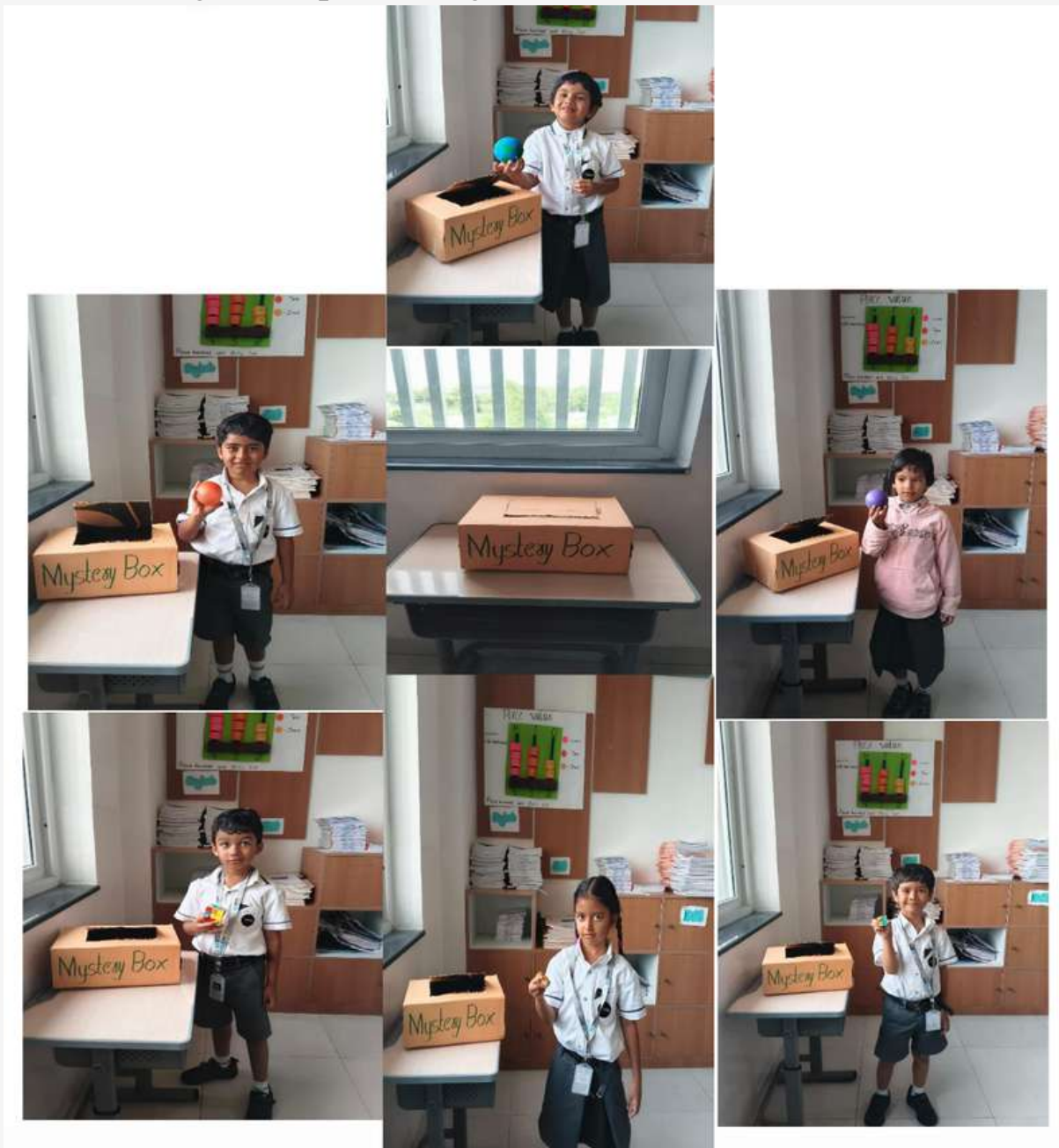
Classroom Highlights

This activity helped them build communication skills, confidence, and expressive vocabulary.

The Grade1 C learners participated in an exciting Mystery Box activity designed to spark curiosity and observation skills. Each child took turns reaching into the box to discover a surprise object — from colourful balls and cubes to tiny models and toys. After revealing their object, students drew its 3D shape and recorded the number of faces, edges, and vertices. This hands-on task helped them connect real-world objects to geometric concepts, reinforcing their understanding of shapes through touch and visualisation.
